Purpose	Off-style is a simple fashion clothing editor platform that provides blank templates of basic clothing categories (i.e. t-shirt, hoodie, sweater, and hat) for all-age fashion designers to customize and modify anything in every section of clothing piece in one place. Customize and modify features, such as adding background color, uploading images, and adding shapes to the blank section. In Off-style, fashion designers can save their projects and export their work to a templated page in PDF format.

Summary of Meeting
